Topic


This term's topic is all about transport. 'Are We There Yet?' will cover different types of transport, the history of its development, the different types of transport used around the world, and link with How Things Move in Science..

English

We'll be continuing with Read, Write Inc each morning, working in different groups so that the children work at the pace that suits their needs. All the children love finding out about the new sound of the day, and are all making great progress in recognising, reading and writing that sound. Many of the children can be found in the Writing Area in their free time, writing lists or words or practising their letters. They are such a keen bunch! As well as following the RWI scheme, we'll continue to work on a new book each Friday. The book links to out Topic, Maths and Science, and it helps the children develop listening skills, word and sounds recognition, and of course, a book is there to be enjoyed! We'll use the story to make story maps, write lists or sentences and sequence events. All of this work prepares them for Year I and the work they'll do in KSI. We have some great texts lined up including; Duck in the Truck, The IOO Decker Bus and Oi, Get off our Train.









Mathe

We'll continue to work on Number, including addition, subtraction, doubling and halving. We'll continue working on number bonds to 5 and ten using objects like multilink and buttons, but also using ten frames as a more formal method. Adding by counting on, and subtracting by counting back are also new methods we'll be tackling.

Computing

Mrs Ferguson will be teaching computing this term, each Wednesday afternoon. She'll be teaching the children how to make videos and take photos using an IPad. The children will learn how to edit and apply filters to their photos.

French

We're learning the En Vacance song, about travelling on a bus. The song teaches the children the French names for mum. Dad, brother, sister, grandma and grandad. It's very catchy and great fun! The children will also learn the names of different transport, play snap and sort them to reinforce the language.

RE

Why do we go on a journey? In RE we'll be looking at visiting a church, and reading stories about religious journeys from people like Jesus, Moses and finding out aboutmass journeys to Mecca and the Ganges river.
